Spectator Code of Conduct

Respect the Athletes

Spectators, both student and adult, must demonstrate courtesy and good sportsmanship by positive cheers of encouragement for THEIR team, not AGAINST the opposing team

Respect the Athletes

Booing, Taunting or using Profanities is not appropriate behaviour at a youth sporting event

Personal, targeted or rude comments about any participant in the game is grounds for immediate removal

Respect the Referees

Respect the referee and their authority over the game by showing proper acceptance of their judgement

Whether you perceive a call to be right or wrong, there is no excuse for verbal abuse

You are capable of disagreeing with a call without loudly verbalizing your objection

Referee abuse of any sorts is grounds for immediate removal
